Centro Comunitário Scalabrini

In January, Accademia granted **13,000€** to **Assistência Social Santa Isabel** (ASSI) for the renovation and extension of this center. The inauguration took place on 21st June.

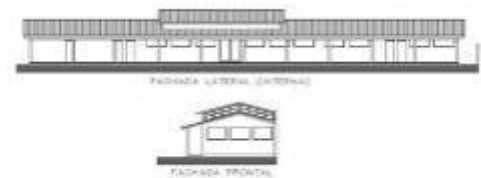


Scalabrini's programming, focused on supporting the community, will include courses that teach basic computing skills to primary school children.

Santa Isabel Parish School

The Santa Isabel Parish School, founded in 1964, serves 395 children between the ages of 6 and 12.

8th September saw the commencement of works for the expansion of the **Santa Isabel Parish** Church School in a vacant lot next to the existing school boundary. Accademia's supporting grant is targeted at **60,000€**.



The extension will house four extra class rooms and a conference area. This will provide space for an additional 60 six-year old children and reduce overcrowding for the remainder. Completion is scheduled for April 2009.

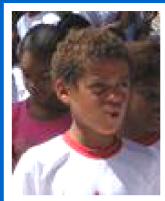

The building of **CEASI** was completed in November 2007, a **130,000 €** investment for **ASSI**, majority funded by Accademia.

In Brazil, the percentage of broadband subscribers in the general population amounts to just 3.2%. Accademia is committed to providing "step changes" in learning for the children of Santa Isabel by leveraging on world-class technology.

VIVO, through its foundation **Instituto Vivo**, now provides free Broadband Wireless 3G Internet access to CEASI. Nationwide publicity was given to the launch of "**Garoto Vivo**" in Santa Isabel. This programming gives rise to possibilities never before believed to be within the reach of Santa Isabel's children.

Dell Foundation donated the twelve new, high-specification, Dual Core Processor PCs.



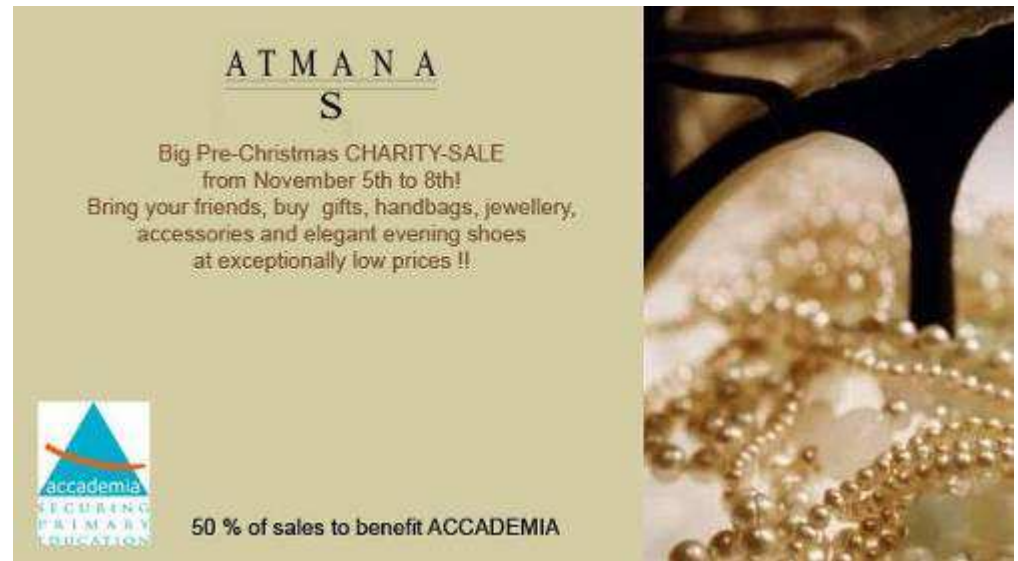
CEASI's new IT Room was entirely furnished and fitted out by VIVO.

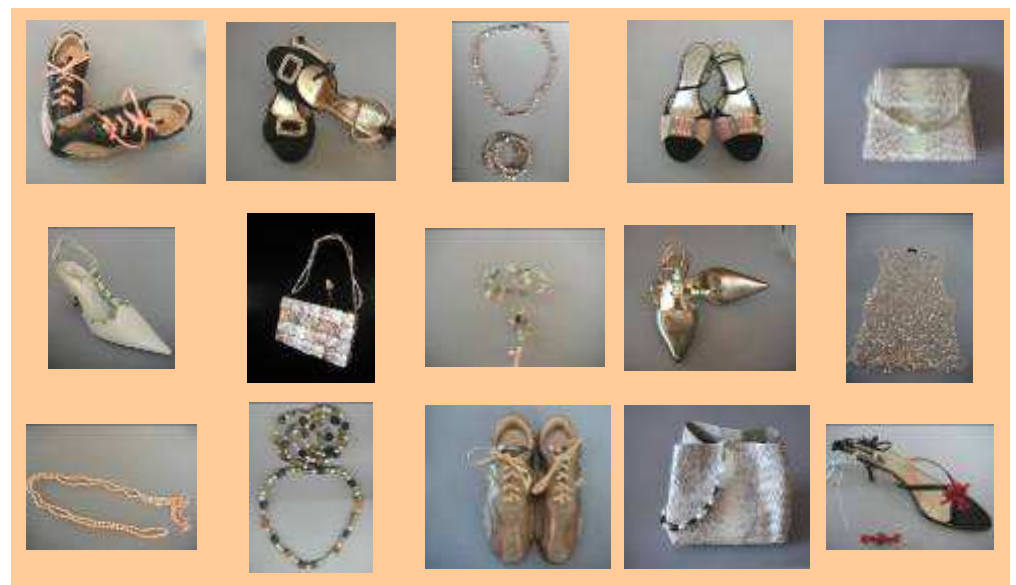
